

Telvent to maintain Gibraltar atmospheric pollution monitoring systems for Cepsa

Madrid, August 2, 2005 – Telvent (NASDAQ TLVT), the Global RealTime IT Company, will provide technical support services for optimization, and preventive and corrective maintenance of the two Cepsa Group atmospheric pollution monitoring systems and the associated control center in the Campo de Gibraltar region.

The emission network is configured within the physical limits of the Cepsa Gibraltar, Interquisa and Petresa plants and consists of a total of 18 focal points (chimneys). The network includes six atmospheric pollution control stations distributed over a 15-kilometer radius around the plants.

The two networks, their communications system and their control center have all been installed by Telvent over the past 18 years that the company has been providing maintenance services for this client.

Between 1988 and February 2005, the Cepsa maintenance contract was renewed each year with no long-term commitment. In March 2005, as a result of a major price reduction for all Cepsa plants, another company obtained the contract. That contract was subsequently cancelled by Cepsa as a result of low data availability, and the contract with Telvent was renewed for a three year period with a CPI-indexed price review. This represents the first time that Telvent has entered into a long-term contractual relationship with this organization.
