

### **Telvent implements the Business Recovery Center for the Andalusian Autonomous Government**

Seville, November 12, 2004 – The Andalusian Autonomous Government will take delivery today (Friday November 12th at 12 p.m.), of the new Security Center hosting that administration's computer systems, located in Avenue Montesierra n ° 36, in Seville.

This Security Center, which was developed by Telvent, the Global RealTime Information Technology Company that began quoting on the Nasdaq stock market on October 21, is the heart of the Phoenix Project, which places the Andalusian Autonomous Government in the forefront of Internet security and communications.

A presentation ceremony will be attended by the Counsellor of Justice and Public Administration, Maria Jose Lopez, and the Counsellor of Innovation, Science and Enterprise, Francisco Vallejo. Both individuals will be touring the facility, beginning at 12:00 p.m., and will be guided by Manuel Salamanca, director of the project, and Adolfo Borrero, Telvent Interactiva's General Manager.

At the conclusion of the presentation ceremony, the individuals in charge of the Phoenix Project will address the media and will present the technical information describing the services that will be provided by the Montesierra facility.

The Security Center occupies 1,500 square meters of space (of which 725 square meters have been allocated for technical service areas), and represents a three million Euro investment in construction, equipment and start-up expenditures. The facility includes two technical services rooms with 60 and 340 square meters of space respectively, and a control room with a surface area of 75 square meters. The remainder of the space will be utilized for building infrastructure, including electrical generators, UPS (uninterrupted power supply) and batteries.

Utilizing the latest technology and security enhancements, this facility will be used to support the computer network systems for the Andalusia Autonomous Government. In addition to providing critical data backup and recovery services, the new facility will also provide the Andalusian Government with a neutral node for its communications network.
